Worried about losing your rods if you tip out?

The Catch 390 has an internal rod chute meaning safe stowage of your rods for getting in and out through the surf line. There's enough fishing gear fitted as standard to get you up and running right away but plenty of accessories you can add on later. There's even fitted internal mounted lugs for batteries and fish-finders and other electronics, so you'll have everything you need within reach.

Some hints to make paddling more fun!

Beach/Fishing:

- Check the tides of the area you're planning on heading out in and whether there are sand bars you could get stuck having to drag your boat back from.
- Keep a small tube of sunscreen and protective lip balm in your personal floatation device (PFD) or lifejacket so you can re-apply it every hour you're out on the water – remember, the sun reflects off the water too!
- If you'll be in water where motor boats are, keep an eye out and make yourself as visible as possible with a high-visibility PFD, a flag – or keep out of busy boating lanes.

Day trips/multi-day trips:

- Carry a small waterproof first aid kit close to the cock-pit where you sit in case you need to access it quickly (as well as a complete kit in your hatch). You never know when you'll need it.
- Even on a perfectly calm and sunny day, practice your rescue techniques – better to know how to do it in good conditions should you need to rescue, you can do so calmly and quickly.
