How to choose the right PFD

It is essential to wear a proper fitting, approved personal floatation device (PFD) when kayaking. A PFD helps keep you afloat and offers upper body protection against obstacles both above and below the water's surface. Choose a PFD that provides a snug, yet comfortable fit. All Mission PFDs come with six adjustment points - four on the side and two at the shoulder - to provide a proper fit. PFDs with a Type 2 (ASSA 1499) Safety Standard have the highest safety rating designed specifically for moving around.

How to choose what to wear

The key to a successful day on the water is to make sure you are wearing the correct clothing. When properly fitted, paddling clothing shouldn't be so tight that it interferes with your range of motion or so loose that it gets caught up in your gear - it should be somewhere comfortable in the middle.

When paddling in warmer conditions, make sure you wear looser fitting, lightweight clothing which breathes easily. Try and avoid clothing that doesn't breathe easily because you'll get sweaty, smelly and uncomfortable. The key is to wear quick drying and lightweight clothing but remember to always bring warm clothes with you because the weather can quickly turn nasty.

In colder conditions, it might pay to wear long sleeves, high collars, gloves and hats to protect your arms, legs, head and hands from the elements. Make sure you wear a waterproof top layer because as soon as your skin gets wet, it becomes much harder to keep warm. Avoid wearing cotton garments because these will freeze you stiff in a matter of minutes if they get wet and will refuse to dry quickly. The range of Mission Kayaking clothing below is a great place to start your kayaking wardrobe.



Warm, hard-wearing unisex shorts

Our Bollocks shorts have a brushed lycra front which is incredibly comfortable and keeps you dry while adventuring. They are also extremely hard wearing and warm thanks to the 3mm neoprene back. **Available in sizes S, M, L, XL & XXL.**



Short or long sleeve first layer

The four-way stretch fabric is designed to be extremely flexible so that you can retain a complete range of movement with no restrictions. These tops pack a lot of warmth for their size thanks to the flat locked seams. Available in both short-sleeves and long-sleeves. Made from comfortable brushed lycra fabric. Available in sizes S, M, L, XL & XXL.

How to choose the right sprayskirt

A well designed sprayskirt is essential for any rough water kayaking, and is a good idea under many conditions. Coated and breathable nylon sprayskirts adjust to fit different waist sizes. Neoprene sprayskirts keep more water out of the cockpit and aren't damaged by chlorine during pool sessions. Regardless of the type of sprayskirt you use, you want it to fit to your body and kayak, but not be so tight that it's difficult to exit the kayak. Remember, the grab-loop must be accessible at all times.



Ideal for club and school use

Ideal for club and school use, the Splashdeck is so durable it will take years of paddling punishment, saving you money! The multifit waist fits all users comfortably so you can save money by buying a 'one-size-fits-all skirt'. Suitable for all Mission Kayaks with cockpits.

How to choose the right paddle

Your paddle has a big impact on how enjoyable paddling will be. A paddle that's poorly made and doesn't fit you can make for a miserable day on the water, while a high quality, well selected paddle is a real delight. Personal preferences definitely figure into your selection. How does it feel? How fast are you going to paddle? How far? These are all important questions to consider and discuss with your dealer. If you can, try out several different styles and lengths to get a feel for what's most comfortable. When choosing a paddle keep these important characteristics in mind:

What design do you need?

- Wide blades provide better acceleration, while long and narrow blades are good for paddling long distances.
- Feathered' paddles are easier to use when paddling into the wind because the blade that's out of the water is horizontal and creates less wind resistance.
- Oval shaped shafts tend to fit the hand better, helping with both comfort and control.

What construction of paddle do you need?

- Paddles are made from many different materials lighter is usually better (and more expensive).
- Paddles made from synthetic materials require less maintenance than timber ones.
- Paddles can be made with a take-apart joint that allows the paddle to be broken down for easier storage and transport, and allows the blades to be set feathered or straight.

What size do you need?

Paddle length is really a matter of personal preference. Go with what feels best. Keep in mind that a longer paddle tends to be necessary if your kayak is wide or if you're more comfortable with a slower paddling stroke. Before buying, try several different lengths to find what feels most comfortable.







Tow tow tow your boat...



The Towpouch consists of a 3m long tow rope packed into a small carry bag and is perfect for sea and river paddling.





Hold onto your paddle

Trying to kayak without a paddle is... well it isn't really kayaking. You don't go anywhere fast and look like a spanner to boot. Secure your paddle to either yourself or your kayak using the paddle leash – you'll find it incredibly useful in surf, rapids and other rough conditions.



The easy way to get your kayak from the car or house to the water

The C-Tug is a versatile take-apart trolley with wide wheels which will keep your kayak upright and stable even when venturing into those more rugged paddling spots. The floating boat pads and adjustable tie down strap will hold your kayak securely without damaging it.



Bail water out of your kayak

This bilge pump is simple to use (basically like a bike pump), tough (strong shaft and heavy duty plastic) and is incredibly effective (it can pump a hefty 30 litres of water per minute out of your kayak). It also has a nifty foam collar so that it keeps floating if you drop it overboard.



Get peace of mind on the water

A must have for any serious ocean or lake kayaker. When you venture away from land you want the security of being able to get yourself back into your kayak if you fall out. By using the Paddle Float you can create a pseudo outrigger for your kayak, allowing you to easily climb back in. Two chambers give it extra buoyancy and there's also a clip on safety tether to eliminate loss in windy conditions.




Protect your noggin
